GUIDANCE

CCGs will not routinely fund treatments for Peyronie's disease. Unless the condition interferes with intercourse it is considered predominantly to be a cosmetic issue and is therefore low priority.

Funding for surgery or treatment with collagenase will be considered on a case by case basis in patients where:

- Conservative self-management treatments have been recommended and tried without success, or rejected by the patient

AND

- The disease has stabilised

AND

- The disease is so significant that intercourse is not possible.

Extracorporeal Shockwave Therapy will not be funded due to inadequate evidence of efficacy.

Applications for funding, both for patients who meet the above criteria and also those who may have exceptional reasons for treatment, should be sent to the CCG Individual Funding Requests department for consideration.
